MADIGAN LAUNCHES THREE-PRONGED ATTACK AGAINST DEADLY SLEEP ENVIRONMENTS FOR INFANTS

Files Unprecedented Lawsuit Against Crib Distributor; Demands Refund-Only Policy from CPSC; Issues Valuable Resource Guide for Parents

Chicago — After months of calling on the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) to take more aggressive action to hold manufacturers and distributors accountable for defective, and often dangerous, products, Attorney General Lisa Madigan today launched a three-pronged approach to better protect Illinois consumers: filing a lawsuit against SFCA, Inc., the distributor of the Simplicity bassinets that have caused two infant deaths, calling on the CPSC to implement a refund-only recall policy, and releasing a new, comprehensive guide outlining recalled cribs, bassinets and play yards to help parents identify whether they have these dangerous products in their homes.

"To protect Illinois families from products that we know are dangerous, we must begin by holding distributors accountable. Our investigation revealed that SFCA continued to distribute recalled products that posed serious risks to children," Madigan said. "I will not allow this company to wash its hands of responsibility to Illinois families."

Madigan's lawsuit alleges that SFCA, which acquired the Simplicity brand and its inventory in March 2008, continued to supply design-flawed bassinets to Illinois retailers, despite knowing the bassinet design had caused at least one death that led to a design change by Simplicity. According to the complaint, SFCA refused to participate in the recall, claiming it wasn't responsible for the design flaws.

Madigan's lawsuit asks the court to prohibit SFCA from selling and distributing the unsafe bassinets in Illinois and to require SFCA to:

- Hire an independent consultant to develop a product safety protocol and review all of SFCA's product designs to ensure compliance with safety standards;
- Recall all Simplicity bassinets that use the recalled design;
- Provide refunds to retailers who issued refunds or store credits to consumers who returned Simplicity bassinets; and
- Notify the public of CPSC recalls by advertising in newspapers throughout Illinois.

Madigan's lawsuit highlights the limitations of the CPSC's recall policy, which allows manufacturers to issue cheap repair kits as remedies instead of offering consumers replacement products, refunds or store credits. The flawed policy allows defective products to remain on the market. For instance, when the CPSC issued an earlier recall of more than 1 million Simplicity cribs, less than 50,000 repair kits had been ordered five months after the recall, leaving hundreds of thousands of dangerous cribs in homes, day care center and secondhand outlets. As a result, Madigan today called on the CPSC to change its policy to require manufacturers and distributors to offer refunds as the sole remedy when babies die as a result of a defective crib or bassinet.

"When a child has died in a defective crib, bassinet or play yard, the burden must remain on the manufacturers and distributors to remove them from the market and help to make families whole," Madigan said. "A cheap repair kit fails to do either."

Madigan also criticized the CPSC's current recall procedure, which she said creates an unfair burden on consumers to interpret the cumbersome and confusing language issued with its notices.

"For busy families, it is virtually impossible to keep track of these recalls," Madigan said. "The information from manufacturers and the CPSC is often unnecessarily complicated and confusing, and too often the recall notices contain long lists of model numbers and lack model names or retailer information that would help families in easily identifying whether their crib or bassinet is covered by the recall."

Madigan offered a simple solution by issuing a [Rest Assured Guide](#), a comprehensive resource to help parents identify dangerous cribs, bassinets and play yards that may still be for sale online and in their communities despite a product recall. The 22-page guide provides helpful product information for nursery furniture that has been recalled in the last 13 months.

"Kids In Danger applauds the work of Attorney General Madigan in protecting Illinois children," said Nancy A. Cowles, Executive Director of Kids In Danger. "The actions announced today, along with this resource on safe sleep environments, are crucial steps in keeping children safe. We will work with our allies in consumer organizations to encourage CPSC to take stronger actions to get dangerous cribs out of homes and off store shelves."

Madigan urged parents to check their crib, bassinet or play yard, and to use this guide when shopping online at sites like Craigslist and eBay or at community resale shops and garage sales.

A Message From Attorney General Lisa Madigan

As you prepare your home for a new baby, you will have many decisions to make. The selection of an infant's crib, or other nursery furniture, is one of the important choices you will face. All parents want to provide their child with the safest sleep environment possible.

In the past year and a half, more than 5.6 million cribs, bassinets and play yards have been recalled by the federal Consumer Product Safety Commission due to a child's death or injury, or the potential for death or injury.

While this system was created to protect consumers from such dangerous products, all too often, recall notices are unclear, leaving consumers unable to determine if their product is part of the recall. In the *Rest Assured* guide, we strive to provide vital information on nine recent recalls of cribs, bassinets and play yards in a format that is simple and easy to use.

Please take a moment to check your crib, bassinet or play yard, and tell your friends and family to do the same. When you are shopping for nursery furniture, including on the secondhand market, keep this guide close by. If you or someone you know owns one of these items, stop using it immediately, and find an alternative sleep environment until you are sure that the item is safe.

The cribs were sold in department stores, children's stores and by mass merchandisers nationwide from January 1998 through May 2007 for between \$100 and \$300.

Why should I be worried?

The drop-side can come off its tracks and detach. This creates a dangerous gap between the crib slats and the mattress. Infants and small children can be trapped in the gap and suffocate.

What should I do?

Stop using the crib immediately. You can return this crib for a full store credit or refund. The Illinois Attorney General's Office may be able to determine where you purchased it. We can also help you make sure that you receive the full store credit or refund to which you are entitled.

Where and when were they sold?

The cribs were sold at department stores, children's stores and by mass merchandisers nationwide from January 2005 through August 2008 for between \$150 and \$300. Retailers include Target, Wal-Mart, Babies "R" Us, Burlington Coat Factory (Baby Depot), K's Merchandise, Meijer, Nebraska Furniture Mart, Shopko and AAFES.

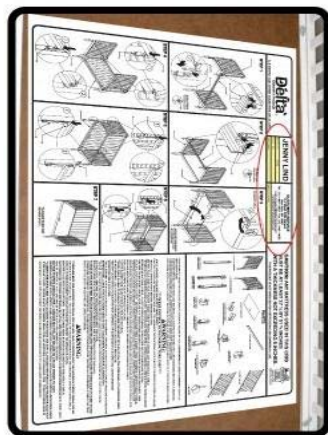

How do I know if I have one of these cribs?

Do you have a Stork Craft Baby Crib with a manufacturing date between May 2000 and November 2008? The manufacturing date is located on the assembly instruction sheet attached to the mattress support board. The firm's insignia, "storkcraft baby," is inscribed on the drop side teething rail of some cribs.

Why should I be worried?

The metal support brackets used to support the crib mattress and mattress board can crack and break. When one or more support brackets break, the mattress can collapse and create a dangerous gap between the mattress and crib rails. Children can be trapped in the gap and suffocate.

What should I do?

Stop using the crib immediately. Contact Stork Craft at 1-866-361-3321 or visit www.storkcraft.com to order the free replacement kit that includes new mattress support brackets.

Where and when were they sold?

Why should I be worried?

All the play yards have raised changing tables with a restraint strap that forms a loop beneath the changing table. One child died because he was strangled on the changing table's restraint strap.

In addition, the Contours 3-in-1 Play Yard has a second defect. It has a raised cradle that rocks back and forth. A child could roll and get trapped against the side of the cradle. If that happens, a child could suffocate. Kolcraft received at least 45 reports of children rolling to the side of the rocking cradle attachment.

What should I do?

Stop using the play yard immediately. Call Kolcraft at 1-888-655-8484 or visit www.kolcraft.com to receive a free non-looped replacement strap for the changing table. If you have a Contours 3-in-1 Play Yard, you can also receive a free repair kit to secure the base of the cradle.

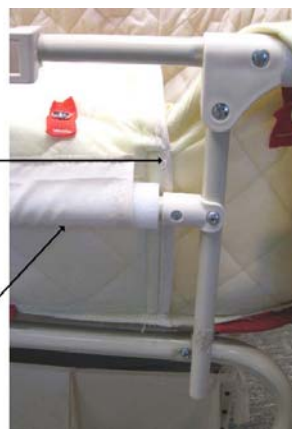

Why should I be worried?

The fabric on one side of the bassinet is attached with Velcro. This allows you to remove the fabric on that side to use the bassinet in the co-sleeping position. However, this defect creates a dangerous gap between the mattress and the lower supporting bar. A child can slip through this gap and suffocate. Two babies have died in these bassinets.

What should I do?

Stop using the bassinet immediately. You can return this bassinet for a full store credit or refund. The Illinois Attorney General's Office may be able to determine where you purchased it. We can also help you to make sure that you receive the full store credit or refund to which you are entitled.

CRIB SAFETY TIPS

Provided by Kids in Danger
A nonprofit organization dedicated to protecting
children by improving children's product safety.

When choosing a crib, be sure that:

- The slats of the crib are close together so that a soda can cannot pass between any of them
- There are no corner post extensions or decorative cut-outs on the crib
- The screws and bolts that secure crib components are not loose or missing
- Crib is free of protruding rivets, metal nuts or bolts, knobs, and wing nuts
- Mattress is tight-fitting; 2 fingers cannot fit between the mattress and crib's side
- Joints and parts fit tightly, and wood is smooth and free of splinters
- There is no cracked or peeling paint, and all painted surfaces are lead-free
- Drop side rails lock properly and securely when in raised position
- Lowered crib sides are at least 9 inches above the mattress support
- Raised crib sides are at least 26 inches above the mattress support in the lowest position

When using a crib, be sure to:

- Read directions for set up, use, and care of the crib. Replacement instructions can be obtained from the manufacturer
- Remove all soft bedding such as pillows, blankets, bumper pads, and stuffed toys
- Use sheets that are tight-fitting
- Check that mattress support hangers do not become disconnected from head/foot-boards
- Position mobiles or hanging crib toys out of child's reach and remove when child starts to push up into a sitting or standing position
- Never hang anything on or above the crib with ribbon or string
- Drop mattress to the lowest position when child can pull himself up
- Stop using a crib with loose or missing attachments or support hardware and contact the manufacturer for replacement hardware
