ATTORNEY GENERAL MADIGAN MOVES TO SHUT DOWN CHICAGO-BASED GROUP POSING AS A CHARITY

Madigan Seeks to Bar Defendants from Ever Operating a Charity in Illinois

Chicago — Attorney General Lisa Madigan today filed a complaint for injunction seeking to shut down the Chicago-based We Stop the Killings organization for operating illegally and soliciting donations from the public. Madigan's injunction also seeks to permanently bar the six defendants from managing any charitable organization in Illinois.

The Attorney General's action, filed in Cook County Circuit Court, alleges that in June 2010 Yolanda King illegally reinstated a long-dissolved charity, Youth Action of the Midwest, naming herself, Warren Jackson, Armatha Kirkwood, Lisa Hendricks, Linda Jabo and Jeanne Taylor as its directors. King renamed the organization, and together the defendants solicited donations from the public, falsely claiming the funds would help prevent youth violence in the Chicago area.

Youth Action of the Midwest operated in the early 1980s but was dissolved by the Secretary of State's office in 1989. Madigan's office discovered the defendants had no involvement whatsoever with the dissolved Youth Action charity and is alleging that by reinstating the organization they violated the state's General Not For Profit Corporation and Solicitation Acts. Madigan's filing also seeks an accounting of all funds raised by the defendants through We Stop the Killings.

"All too often we see defendants like these preying on unsuspecting people who donate hoping they are giving back and helping those in need," Attorney General Madigan said. "Before donating your money, ask questions and take time to do research about the charity. Make sure you are satisfied your money is really going to a good cause."

Madigan urged the public to take a close look at any charity that solicits donations. To learn whether a charity or fundraising organization has to be registered in Illinois or to report suspicious solicitations, contact the Attorney General's Charitable Trust Bureau, (312) 814-2595 or visit www.illinoisattorneygeneral.gov/charities/index.html.

To best ensure that your donation will be used for its intended purpose, the Attorney General offered the following tips:

- **Ask how much of your donation will go to the charity and how much will be used to pay fundraising costs.** Solicitors must give you this information if you ask.
- **Pay close attention to the name of the charity.** Some fraudulent charities use names that sound or look like those of legitimate organizations in an effort to mislead you.
- **Ask questions about the charity.** Donate only when your questions have been answered and you are certain your money will be used according to your wishes. Questions to ask include whether the charity is registered with the Illinois Attorney General's office and what percentage of donations to the charity go to fundraising, administration and charitable programming.
- **Do not pay in cash.** For security and tax record purposes, pay by check. Be sure to write the full official name of the charity on your check – do not abbreviate.
- **Request written information.** A legitimate charity will provide you with written information outlining its mission, how your donation will be distributed and proof that your contribution is tax deductible.

- **Do not donate if the solicitor uses high-pressure tactics, asks for cash payment or insists on sending someone to pick up your donation.** These are all hallmarks of a scam.

**VERIFIED COMPLAINT FOR AN INJUNCTION, AN ACCOUNTING, JUDICIAL
DISSOLUTION, AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF**

NOW COMES the Plaintiff, the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS *ex rel.* LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of Illinois, and complains of Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS formerly known as (f/k/a) Youth Action of the Midwest, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO, and states as follows:

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS / PARTIES

1. This cause is brought for and on behalf of the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS by and through the Attorney General of Illinois pursuant to Article 12 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 (805 ILCS 105/112 *et sec.*), the Solicitation For Charity Act (225 ILCS 0.01 *et seq.*), and her common law power and duty to protect the interests of THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, as ultimate beneficiaries, in matters pertaining to charitable organizations and the integrity of charitable assets and funds solicited and collected for charitable purposes.

2. The PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS are the ultimate beneficiary or *cestui que trust* of

all Illinois charitable assets and property, and the Attorney General, in her capacity as the legal representative of the PEOPLE OF ILLINOIS, has the common law power and duty to protect the interests of the PEOPLE OF ILLINOIS in all such property, including by any legal proceedings.

3. Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS formerly known as (f/k/a) Youth Action of the Midwest (hereinafter "WSTK") is an Illinois not-for-profit corporation originally incorporated on May 24, 1978 with the Illinois Secretary of State for exclusively charitable purposes. (Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A" is a copy of WSTK's Articles of Incorporation.)

4. Defendant WSTK's registered agent as listed on its most recent annual report filed with the Illinois Secretary of State is Defendant YOLANDA KING whose registered address is 1355 N. Sandburg Terrace #2103D, Chicago, Illinois 60610.

5. At all relevant times, Defendant WSTK has maintained the internet website "www.westopthekillings.org," (hereinafter the "WSTK Website") which, among other things, **(a)** represents to the public that "WSTK is an organization committed to serving disenfranchised communities"; **(b)** solicits "donations and contributions [to] empower us to pursue our mission to eradicate youth violence and incite personal responsibility and transformation"; and **(c)** collects contributions via PayPal. (Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Group Exhibit "B" is a copy of relevant portions of the WSTK Website.)

6. As a consequence of the foregoing, Defendant WSTK is, and was at all times relevant hereto, a "charitable organization" as that term is defined in Section 1(a) of the Solicitation For Charity Act (225 ILCS 460/1(a)).

7. Defendant YOLANDA KING (hereinafter "KING") is an Illinois resident who, beginning June 16, 2010, began filing WSTK documents with the Illinois Secretary of State listing herself as, among other things, WSTK's Registered Agent, WSTK's President, and a member of WSTK's Board of Directors. As such, KING is a natural person responsible for the acts and practices of WSTK as hereinafter alleged.

8. Defendant WARREN JACKSON (hereinafter "JACKSON") is an Illinois resident who, beginning June 16, 2010, was listed on WSTK documents filed with the as the Illinois Secretary of State as WSTK's treasurer and a member of its Board of Directors. In addition, according to the website "www.westopthekillings.org," Defendant JACKSON is "the prime mover of ...We Stop The Killings, an organization designed to produce entrepreneurship opportunities, transformation through personal development, motivation and guidance among Chicago's youth." (See Group Exhibit "B".) As such, JACKSON is a natural person responsible for the acts and practices of WSTK as hereinafter alleged.

9. Defendants ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD (hereinafter "KIRKWOOD"), LISA HENDRICKS (hereinafter "HENDRICKS"), and JEANNE TAYLOR (hereinafter "TAYLOR") are each Illinois residents. Upon information and belief, Defendant LINDA JABO (hereinafter "JABO"), is a resident of Ohio. Beginning June 16, 2010 and continuing through the present, Defendants KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO were listed on WSTK documents filed with the Illinois Secretary of State as members of the Board of Directors of Defendant WSTK.

10. As a consequence of serving as officers and/or directors of Defendant WSTK as aforesaid, Defendants KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO are each a charitable "trustee" as that term is defined in Section 1(n) of the Solicitation Act (225 ILCS 460/1(n)) and Section 3 of the Trust Act (760 ILCS 55/3).

11. As previously alleged, Defendant WSTK was originally incorporated on May 24, 1978 with the name "Youth Action of the Midwest." Youth Action of the Midwest originally operated as a functioning charitable entity and it was registered as a "charitable organization" and filed annual accountings with the Attorney General as required under the Solicitation Act for the periods from at least 1980 through 1989. However, Youth Action of the Midwest ceased to function in 1989 and its registration with the Attorney General was cancelled on June 12, 1993, and it never re-registered.

12. On or about October 2, 1989, the Illinois Secretary of State issued a Certificate of Dissolution dissolving Youth Action of the Midwest as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation pursuant to Section 112.40 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 (805 ILCS 105/112.40) after Youth Action of the Midwest failed to file annual reports with the Secretary of State as required by said Act, and Youth Action of the Midwest remained dissolved for over 20 years. (Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "C" is a copy of said October 2, 1989 Certificate of Dissolution.)

13. The last annual report filed by Youth Action of the Midwest with the Illinois Secretary of State prior to its dissolution by the Secretary of State on October 2, 1989 was dated April 10, 1987 and listed the following five persons as serving as officers and directors of Youth Action of the Midwest:

(Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "D" is a copy of the first page of Youth Action of the Midwest's April 10, 1987 annual report filed with the Illinois Secretary of State.)

14. Despite the fact that Youth Action of the Midwest had ceased to function and was dissolved as

a not-for-profit corporation on October 2, 1989 as aforesaid, on or about June 16, 2010, Defendants filed documents with the Illinois Secretary of State purporting to be (a) an Application of Reinstatement as a Domestic Corporation under Section 112.45 of the General Not-For-Profit Corporation Act (805 ILCS 105/112.45) for Youth Action of the Midwest; (b) a Statement of Change of Registered Agent and Registered Office for Youth Action of the Midwest, changing its registered agent from Robert B. Creamer to Defendant KING and changing its registered office from 220 S. State Street, Chicago, Illinois 60604 to 1355 N. Sandberg Terrace #2103D, Chicago, Illinois 60610; (c) Annual Reports for Youth Action of the Midwest for the years 1989 through 2010, listing Defendants KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO as the officers and directors of Youth Action of the Midwest in each of those years; and (d) Articles of Amendment for Youth Action of the Midwest, changing the corporate name to WE STOP THE KILLINGS. (Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "E" is a copy of the purported Application of Reinstatement as a Domestic Corporation for Youth Action of the Midwest filed with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010. Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "F" is a copy of the purported Statement of Change of Registered Agent and Registered Office for Youth Action of the Midwest filed with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010. Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Group Exhibit "G" is a copy of the first page of each of the purported Annual Reports of Youth Action of the Midwest for the years 1989 through 2010 filed with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010. And, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "H" is a copy of the purported Articles of Amendment for Youth Action of the Midwest, changing its corporate name to WE STOP THE KILLINGS, filed with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010.)

15. All of the documents that the Defendants filed with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010 to reinstate Youth Action of the Midwest as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation and to change its

corporate name to WE STOP THE KILLINGS (hereinafter “WSTK”) were signed by Defendant KING, under penalty of perjury, as a purported authorized officer of Youth Action of the Midwest. (See Exhibits “E”, “F”, “G”, and “H” hereto.)

16. Although Defendants filed multiple documents with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010 which were signed by Defendant KING (Exhibits “E”, “F”, “G”, and “H” hereto) stating under penalty of perjury that KING was an authorized officer of Youth Action of the Midwest and that the officers and directors of Youth Action of the Midwest from 1989 through 2010 included KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO, the Attorney General has contacted two of the persons — namely, Robert B. Creamer and Mary H. Schaafsma — listed as the officers and directors on Youth Action of the Midwest’s April 10, 1987 annual report filed with the Secretary of State (Exhibit “D” hereto), each of whom have provided affidavits stating, among other things, that **(a)** the five persons listed on the April 10, 1987 annual report were the last duly authorized officers and directors of Youth Action of the Midwest, both prior to and after its dissolution on October 2, 1989; **(b)** Youth Action of the Midwest ceased to exist after it was dissolved on October 2, 1989; and **(c)** no person named YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMATHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, or LINDA JABO, or was ever authorized to act or hold themselves out as officers, directors, employees or agents of Youth Action of the Midwest. (Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibits “I” and “J” respectively are the affidavits of Robert B. Creamer and Mary H. Schaafsma attesting to the foregoing.)

17. Based on Exhibits “I” and “J” hereto, all of the documents filed by Defendants with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010 to reinstate Youth Action of the Midwest as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation and to change its corporate name to WE STOP THE KILLINGS — all of which were signed by Defendant KING under penalty of perjury (*see* Exhibits “E”, “F”, “G”, and “H”) — falsely stated that

Defendant KING was an authorized officer of Youth Action of the Midwest and that Defendants KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, or JABO were authorized officers and directors of Youth Action of the Midwest from 1989 through 2010, when they were not.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

18. The Plaintiff is the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS. Defendant WSTK is an Illinois not-for-profit corporation. Defendants KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR are Illinois residents. In addition, Defendants WSTK, KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO are officers and directors of an Illinois not for profit corporation that has conducted business in Illinois to solicit and collect charitable contributions from the Illinois public, as aforesaid. Therefore, this Court has jurisdiction over the parties and over the subject matter of this action.

19. The list of registrations of charitable organizations required to be registered under the Solicitation For Charity Act, 225 ILCS 460/1 *et seq.*, is accepted and maintained by the Attorney General in her office in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois. As such, venue of this action is proper in Cook County, Illinois pursuant to Section 5 of the Solicitation For Charity Act. (225 ILCS 460/5.)

COUNT I **JUDICIAL DISSOLUTION OF WE STOP THE KILLINGS**

1-19. The Plaintiff hereby repeats and re-alleges Paragraphs 1-19 of this Complaint as Paragraphs 1-19 of Count I, and incorporates the same by reference as though fully set forth herein.

20. This Count is brought for and on behalf of the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS by and through the Attorney General of Illinois pursuant to Article 12 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 (805 ILCS 105/112 *et sec.*), as well as her common law power and duty to protect the

interests of THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS in matters pertaining to charitable organizations and the integrity of charitable assets and charitable organizations.

21. The Plaintiff, by this Count, seeks the judicial dissolution of Defendant WSTK as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation and to protect and safeguard all assets and property solicited and collected by Defendant WSTK and its purported officers and directors in Illinois pursuant to their charitable solicitations as set forth above by and through the appointment of a receiver to hold, marshal, manage and protect said charitable assets.

22. As previously set forth above, Defendant WSTK was administratively dissolved as an Illinois not-for-profit corporation on or about October 2, 1989 (*see* Exhibit “C”) and WSTK remained dissolved until June 16, 2010 when the Defendants filed with the Illinois Secretary of State documents on behalf of Youth Action of the Midwest — including an Application For Reinstatement, a Statement of Change of Registered Agent and Registered Office, Annual Reports for the years 1989 through 2010, and Articles of Amendment changing its corporate name to WSTK — all of which were signed by Defendant KING under penalty of perjury (*see* Exhibits “E”, “F”, “G”, and “H”) falsely stating that Defendant KING was an authorized officer of Youth Action of the Midwest and that Defendants KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO were authorized officers and directors of Youth Action of the Midwest from 1989 through 2010, when they were not. (*See* Exhibits “I” and “J” hereto.)

23. Consequently, WSTK’s certificate of incorporation was reinstated on June 16, 2010 only because Defendants filed with the Illinois Secretary of State documents signed by Defendant KING under penalty of perjury but which contained materially false statements as aforesaid.

24. Section 112.50(a) of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 provides in pertinent

part as follows:

Sec. 112.50. Grounds for judicial dissolution. A Circuit Court may dissolve a corporation:

(a) In an action by the Attorney General, if it is established that:

(1) The corporation obtained its certificate of incorporation through fraud.

(805 ILCS 105/112.50)

25. In addition, Section 112.65 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 provides:

Sec. 112.65. Order of dissolution. (a) If, after a hearing, the court determines that one or more grounds for judicial dissolution described in Section 112.50 of this Act exists, it may enter an order dissolving the corporation and the clerk of the court shall deliver a certified copy of the order to the Secretary of State, who shall file the order, and to the Recorder of the county in which the registered office of the corporation is located, who shall record the order.

(b) After entering the order of dissolution, the court shall direct the winding up and liquidation of the corporation's affairs in accordance with Sections 112.16 and 112.30 of this Act and the notification of its known claimants in accordance with Section 112.75 of this Act and shall retain jurisdiction until the same is complete.

(805 ILCS 105/112.65)

26. As a consequence of filing incorporation documents with the Illinois Secretary of State on June 16, 2010 containing materially false information as aforesaid, WSTK's certificate of incorporation was obtained through fraud and the Attorney General therefore seeks to have Defendant WSTK judicially dissolved pursuant to Sections 112.50(a) and 112.65 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986.

27. Section 112.60 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 provides in pertinent part as follows:

Sec. 112.60. (d) The circuit court in an action for judicial dissolution may issue injunctions, appoint an interim receiver with such powers and duties as the court, from time to time, may direct, and take such other action as is necessary or desirable to preserve the corporate assets and carry on the affairs of the corporation until a full hearing can be had.

(e) Upon a hearing and after finding that grounds for judicial dissolution exist ... the court may appoint a liquidating receiver or receivers with authority to collect the assets of the corporation, including all amounts owing to the corporation by members...

*

*

*

(j) The assets of the corporation or the proceeds resulting from a sale, conveyance, or other disposition thereof shall be applied and distributed as follows:

(1) All costs and expenses of the court proceedings and all liabilities and obligations of the corporation shall be paid, satisfied and discharged, or adequate provision shall be made therefor;

(2) Assets held by the corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution or liquidation, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements;

(3) Assets held for a charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational or similar use... shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more ... corporations, societies or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the dissolving or liquidating corporation as the court may direct...

(805 ILCS 105/112.60(d), 112.60(e), and 112.60(j).)

28. All property of Defendant WSTK, including but not limited to any and all monies collected and held by Defendant WSTK, including any contributions made in response to the Defendants' online solicitation efforts as alleged herein is charitable property and is impressed with a charitable trust by operation of law.

29. Pursuant to Section 112.60 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986, Plaintiff requests that (a) a receiver be appointed to protect and conserve the assets of WSTK until further order of the Court and (b) all said property and assets be transferred to one or more Illinois charitable organization(s) engaged in *bona fide* charitable activities similar to those set forth in Defendant WSTK's original articles of incorporation.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS *ex rel.* LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of Illinois, prays that this Honorable Court enter an Order:

A. Pursuant to Sections 112.50(a) and 112.65 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 (805 ILCS 105/112.50(a) and 105/112.65):

1. Finding that Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest obtained its certificate of incorporation through fraud; and

2. Declaring Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest to be judicially dissolved;
- B. Pursuant to Sections 112.60 of the General Not For Profit Corporation Act of 1986 (805 ILCS 105/112.60):
1. Directing Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, and its officers and directors, including but not limited to Defendants YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO to make a strict accounting of all WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest assets, receipts, expenses and disbursements from all funds raised, collected and/or promised as a result of the Defendants' solicitations as alleged herein;
 2. Declaring that all contributions received by Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest as a result of the Defendants' solicitations as alleged herein are held in constructive trust for the benefit of the PEOPLE OF ILLINOIS as the ultimate beneficiaries of charity and that such monies should be transferred to one or more Illinois charitable organization(s) engaged in *bona fide* charitable activities similar to those set forth in Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest's original articles of incorporation;
 3. Temporarily restraining and preliminarily and permanently enjoining Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO and all persons acting in concert or participation with them, whether by contract or otherwise, from:
 - a) Soliciting, receiving or holding assets for any charitable or ostensibly

charitable purpose or on behalf of any Illinois-based charitable or ostensibly-charitable trust or entity, and from acting in any fiduciary capacity with respect to charitable assets;

- b) Disbursing, transferring, expending, or liquidating any funds, assets, bank accounts or depository accounts without court approval, and freezing all such funds, assets and accounts; and
- c) Transferring, selling or encumbering any assets or property until the resolution of this cause; and

4. Removing Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest and its officers and directors, including but not limited to Defendants YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO, as trustees and/or custodians of all solicited charitable assets of WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest they may hold, and naming replacement Trustees and/or a Receiver in their stead to identify, locate, collect and marshal all such assets, and/or transferring all such charitable assets to one or more Illinois charitable organization(s) engaged in *bona fide* charitable activities similar to those set forth in Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest's original articles of incorporation;

- C. Requiring Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest to pay the costs incurred in the investigation and prosecution of this cause; and
- D. Granting such other and further relief as this Court deems just and equitable under the circumstances of this cause.

COUNT II
UNREGISTERED FUND RAISING
IN VIOLATION OF THE SOLICITATION FOR CHARITY ACT

1-29. The Plaintiff hereby repeats and re-alleges Paragraphs 1-29 of Count I of this Complaint as Paragraphs 1-29 of Count II, and incorporates the same by reference as though fully set forth herein.

30. At all relevant times hereto there was in existence and effect in Illinois a statute governing the solicitation and collection of funds for charitable purposes in the State of Illinois, namely the Solicitation For Charity Act (225 ILCS 460/1 *et seq.*) (hereafter the "Solicitation Act").

31. With certain limited exceptions set forth in the Act which are not relevant here, Section 2 of the Solicitation Act requires all charitable organizations which solicit or intend to solicit funds from the public in or from the State of Illinois to be registered with the Illinois Attorney General prior to conducting any solicitations. Section 2(a) provides in pertinent part:

Every charitable organization, except as otherwise provided in Section 3 of this Act [225 ILCS 460/3], which solicits or intends to solicit contributions from persons in this State or which is located in this State, by any means whatsoever shall, prior to any solicitation, file with the Attorney General upon forms prescribed by him, a registration statement

(225 ILCS 460/2(a).)

32. As previously alleged, Defendant WSTK was originally incorporated on May 24, 1978 with the name "Youth Action of the Midwest" and WSTK (Youth Action of the Midwest) originally operated as a functioning charitable entity that was registered as a "charitable organization" with the Attorney General as required under Section 2 of the Solicitation Act; however, as previously alleged, WSTK (Youth Action of the Midwest) ceased to operate as a not-for-profit corporation and it was dissolved by the Illinois Secretary of State on October 2, 1989.

33. After WSTK (Youth Action of the Midwest) ceased to function and its corporate status was dissolved by the Illinois Secretary of State in 1989, WSTK (Youth Action of the Midwest) failed to file an annual report for the fiscal period ending April 30, 1990 or any subsequent periods and WSTK's (Youth Action of the Midwest's) registration with the Attorney General was cancelled after notice on or about June 12, 1993, and Defendant WSTK has never re-registered.

34. As previously alleged, beginning on at least June 16, 2010 and continuing through the present, the Defendants herein have, among other things, **(a)** filed documents with the Illinois Secretary of State purporting to reinstate the corporate status of Action of the Midwest and change its name to WSTK and **(b)** maintained a WSTK website at "www.westopthekillings.org" soliciting and collecting charitable contributions from the public representing that donations to WSTK will be used "to eradicate youth violence and incite personal responsibility and transformation." (See Group Exhibit "B" hereto.)

35. Despite operating WSTK and soliciting for charitable purposes as set forth above, Defendants WSTK, KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO failed to register WSTK as a charitable organization with the Illinois Attorney General prior to soliciting, and therefore they have each failed to comply with Section 2(a) of the Solicitation Act in violation of Illinois law.

36. Section 2(i) of the Solicitation Act provides:

Sec. 2(i) If a person, organization, or trustee fails to register or if registration is cancelled as provided in this Act, the person, organization, or trustee is subject to injunction, to removal, to account, and to appropriate other relief before the circuit court exercising chancery jurisdiction. In addition to any other relief granted under this Act, the court shall impose a civil penalty of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000 against each and every trustee, organization, and person who fails to register or who fails to maintain a registration required under this Act. The collected penalty funds shall be used for charitable trust enforcement and for providing charitable trust information to the public.

(225 ILCS 460/2(i).)

37. By failing to register WSTK prior to soliciting in Illinois as required by Section 2(a) of the Solicitation Act, Defendants WSTK, KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO are therefore each subject to injunction, to removal, to account, and to other appropriate relief as provided for in Section 2(i) of the Solicitation Act.

38. In addition, based on the foregoing allegations in this Count, Defendants WSTK, KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO are subject to the relief provided for in Section 9(c) of the Solicitation Act, which provides in pertinent part as follows:

Whenever the Attorney General shall have reason to believe that any charitable organization ...is operating in violation of the provisions of this Act ... he may bring in the circuit court an action in the name, and on behalf of the people of the State of Illinois against each such charitable organization ... to enjoin such charitable organization ... from continuing such solicitation or collection, or engaging therein or doing any acts in furtherance thereof, or to cancel any registration statement previously filed with the Attorney General.

(f) In any action brought under the provisions of this Act, the Attorney General is entitled to recover costs for the use of this State.

(g) Any person who knowingly violates this Section may be enjoined from such conduct, removed from office, enjoined from acting for charity and subject to punitive damages as deemed appropriate by the circuit court.

(h) Any person who violates this Section shall not be entitled to keep or receive monies, fees, salaries, commissions or any compensation, as a result of the solicitations or fund raising campaigns, and at the request of the Attorney General such monies, fees, salaries, commissions, or any compensation shall be forfeited and subject to distribution to charitable use as a court of equity determines.

(225 ILCS 460/9(c), (f), (g), and (h).)

39. In addition, Section 16(b) of the Solicitation Act provides:

(b) Upon an application to a court of competent jurisdiction, in which the Attorney General alleges that a charitable trust needs to be protected or the trustees of a charitable organization or trust have engaged in a breach of fiduciary duty toward the organization, and he seeks injunctive relief and removal of such trustees, the Court may, as part of the injunctive relief and after a hearing where such trustees shall have an opportunity to be heard, appoint temporarily or permanently a receiver or additional trustees to protect and operate the organization and may temporarily, or as ultimate relief for breach of duty or to protect the trust, permanently remove any charitable organization's trustees, corporate officers, directors and members from office and appoint replacements to protect the public interest.

(225 ILCS 460/16(b).)

40. Any and all monies collected and held by the Defendants in response to their charitable solicitation campaign using among other things the WSTK Website as alleged herein is charitable property and is impressed with a charitable trust by operation of law. As a consequence of Defendants' violations of the Solicitation Act as set forth herein, the charitable trust under which such monies are held is in need of protection.

41. To safeguard and protect the integrity of the charitable assets held by the Defendants as proceeds of charity as aforesaid, Defendants WSTK, KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO should be removed as charitable trustees and should be temporarily, preliminarily and permanently restrained and enjoined from acting in any fiduciary capacity with respect to charitable assets in Illinois pursuant to Sections 9(c) and 16(b) of the Solicitation Act, and new trustees or a receiver should be appointed by the Court in their stead to identify, locate, collect, marshal, and act as fiduciaries of all WSTK monies and assets solicited and collected by the Defendants pursuant to their charitable solicitations as set forth above, and their fruits and proceeds in whatever form and wherever situated. (225 ILCS 460/9(c) and 16(b).)

42. In addition, Defendants WSTK, KING, JACKSON, KIRKWOOD, HENDRICKS, TAYLOR, and JABO should be made to fully account for all monies and assets solicited and collected as a result of their charitable solicitations as aforesaid, and said Defendants should be surcharged at equity for all such charitable assets of WSTK that are found to have been misused and/or for which the Defendants are unable to fully account.

43. Plaintiff requests that this Court enter an Order imposing a constructive trust in favor of charity and the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS over all remaining collected WSTK funds still in the

possession of the Defendants. Furthermore, all such funds should be removed from the Defendants' custody and should be transferred and directed to one or more *bona fide* charitable organizations organized for purposes similar to those represented by the Defendants to prospective donors.

44. By the conduct of the Defendants as alleged herein, violations of the provisions of the Solicitation Act have occurred, and irreparable harm has occurred and is continuing to occur to charity and to the Plaintiff, the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, for which there is no adequate remedy save in a court of equity.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS *ex rel.* LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of Illinois, prays that this Honorable Court enter an Order:

- A. Finding and adjudging that Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO have each violated the Solicitation For Charity Act (225 ILCS 460/1 *et seq.*);
- B. Directing Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO to make a strict accounting of all WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest assets, receipts, expenses and disbursements from all funds raised, collected and/or promised as a result of the Defendants' solicitations as alleged herein;
- C. Pursuant to Sections 2(i), 9(c), and 16(b) of the Solicitation Act, temporarily restraining and preliminarily and permanently enjoining Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON,

ARMANTHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO, and all persons acting in concert or participation with them, whether by contract or otherwise, from:

- 1) Soliciting, receiving or holding assets for any charitable or ostensibly charitable purpose or on behalf of any Illinois-based charitable or ostensibly-charitable trust or entity, including but not limited to WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, and/or from acting in any fiduciary capacity with respect to charitable assets;
 - 2) Disbursing, transferring, expending, or liquidating any funds, assets, bank accounts or depository accounts without court approval, and freezing all such funds, assets and accounts; and
 - 3) Transferring, selling or encumbering any assets or property until the resolution of this cause;
- D. Surcharging Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANATHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO at equity for such amounts of charitable funds as the Court deems to have been misused and/or wasted, plus an additional sum for all assets and monies for which they are unable to fully account, plus interest at market rates through the present;
- E. Entering judgment in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANATHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO in an amount to be determined by the Court after an accounting;
- F. Removing Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest,

YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANATHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO as trustees and/or custodians of all solicited charitable assets of WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest they may hold, and of the fruits and proceeds of all charitable solicitations conducted by them and/or in their hands pursuant to Section 2(i) and/or 16(b) of the Solicitation Act, and naming replacement Trustees and/or a Receiver in their stead to identify, locate, collect and marshal all such assets, and/or transferring all such assets, under the doctrines of *cy pres* and/or equitable deviation, to one or more Illinois charitable organization(s) engaged in *bona fide* charitable activities similar to those represented to actual and/or prospective donors and/or similar to those set forth in Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest's original articles of incorporation;


- G. Imposing a constructive trust and directing that all WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest funds collected, held or received by Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest from the Defendants' solicitations as alleged herein, and their fruits and proceeds, be transferred to one or more Illinois charitable organization(s) engaged in *bona fide* charitable activities similar to those set forth in Defendant WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest's original articles of incorporation;
- H. In addition, imposing a civil penalty of between \$500 and \$1,000 each against Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANATHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO pursuant to Section 2(i) of the Solicitation For Charity Act (225 ILCS 460/2(i)), said amounts to be used by the Attorney General of

Illinois for charitable trust enforcement and for providing charitable trust information to the public pursuant to said Section;

- I. Requiring Defendants WE STOP THE KILLINGS f/k/a Youth Action of the Midwest, YOLANDA KING, WARREN JACKSON, ARMANHA KIRKWOOD, LISA HENDRICKS, JEANNE TAYLOR, and LINDA JABO to pay the costs incurred in the investigation and prosecution of this cause, as provided by Section 9(g) of the Solicitation For Charity Act (225 ILCS 460/9(g)); and
- J. Granting such other and further relief as this Court deems just and equitable under the circumstances of this cause.

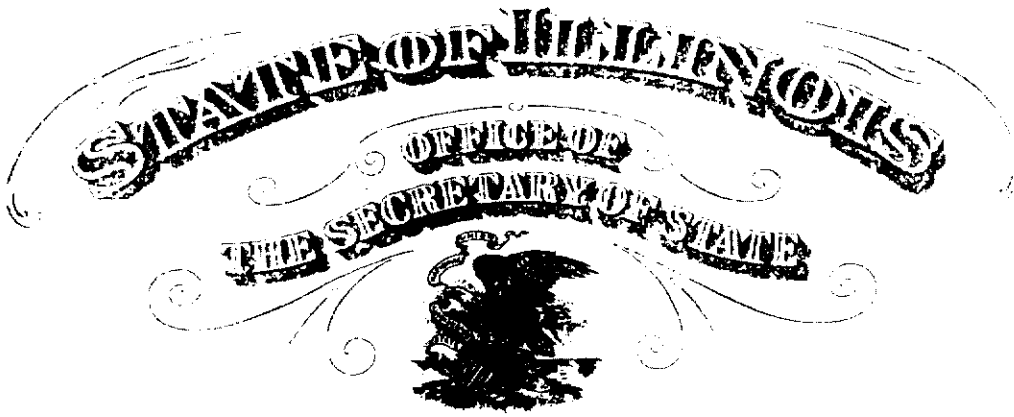

The Corporation shall not directly or indirectly participate or intervene in political campaigns on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
