

## **OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL DISABILITY RIGHTS BUREAU** INVESTIGATION AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ACTIVITY REPORT ON FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021

Public Act 101-537 took effect on August 23, 2019. It requires that by July 31 each year, the Attorney General's office must provide data about the office's efforts to enforce the Environmental Barriers Act, 410 ILCS 25/1 et seq. This report includes data regarding enforcement of the Environmental Barriers Act during fiscal year 2020-2021. As of the initial publication date of this report, certain categories of data were unavailable due to the compromise of the computer network for the Attorney General's office discovered on April 10, 2021. The previously unavailable data has now been compiled and incorporated into this updated report.
