



Foundation Training on Responding to Acute Sexual Assault Survivors

The Illinois Attorney General's Office is pleased to offer a webinar training to assist medical professionals, sexual assault service providers, law enforcement and prosecutors in caring for sexual assault survivors.

While this webinar does not provide continuing education credits, it does fulfill the statutory requirements for emergency department clinical staff at both treatment and transfer facilities pursuant to the Sexual Assault Survivors Emergency Treatment Act (SASETA). Additional training is required on hospital-specific sexual assault policies and procedures to meet the requirement.

The training will cover the medical forensic examination, the Illinois State Police Sexual Assault Evidence Collection Kit, sexual assault epidemiology, the neurobiology of trauma, drug-facilitated sexual assault, child sexual abuse, and Illinois sexual assault laws.

If you are thinking about becoming a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) or Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner (SAFE), this training is the perfect starting point.
