Organizations can now file: registrations, AG990-IL, extension requests, religious exemptions, letter of good standing and community benefits reports.

Professional Fund Raisers can now file: registrations, annual financial reports, six-month financial reports, extensions, contracts and professional solicitor registrations.

Professional Fundraising Consultants can now file: registrations and contracts.

After creating an account, the system will guide you as you complete, submit, and pay fees for necessary filings. The range of forms includes: initial registrations, annual/ 6-month reports, community benefits reports, or requests for extensions.

You can also update an organization's address or name.

Manage Your Filings

You are able to save drafts of your filings as you go and return to complete them at your convenience. You can also view the status of open filings and see what tasks are outstanding.

Access Your Completed Filings

View all your completed filings in one location. After a filing is accepted, it remains accessible in your account for convenient reference. You can also download Letters of Good Standing for an organization in your online filing account.

Please note that registration and report filings are processed by the Charitable Trust Bureau in the order received, with priority given to those filings made through this online filing portal.

To register or re-register a charitable organization in Illinois, you will be required to complete a Charitable Organization Registration Statement (Form CO-1). A registration fee of \$15.00 is required for all new registrations. A re-registration fee of \$200 is required for all re-registrations.

An AG990-IL is due within six months after the organization's fiscal year end (see instructions for AG990-IL). Organizations which have been in operation less than one (1) year, and are not yet required to file an AG990-IL, must attach a completed Financial Information Form CO-2.

If you are a religious organization, seeking a religious exemption from filing annual financial reports, you must also submit a Charitable Organization Religious Exemption Form (Form CO-3) as part of this registration process.

- Once all forms have been completed and attachments uploaded, system will guide user through signature process
- All signatures must be obtained before filing can be submitted
- Each form that requires attestation will have its own electronic signature process
- Each form requiring a signature will have data fields for the user to enter email addresses for the person(s) who sign the form under penalty of perjury
- If two signatures are required on the form, each person will receive his or her own email to complete this process.

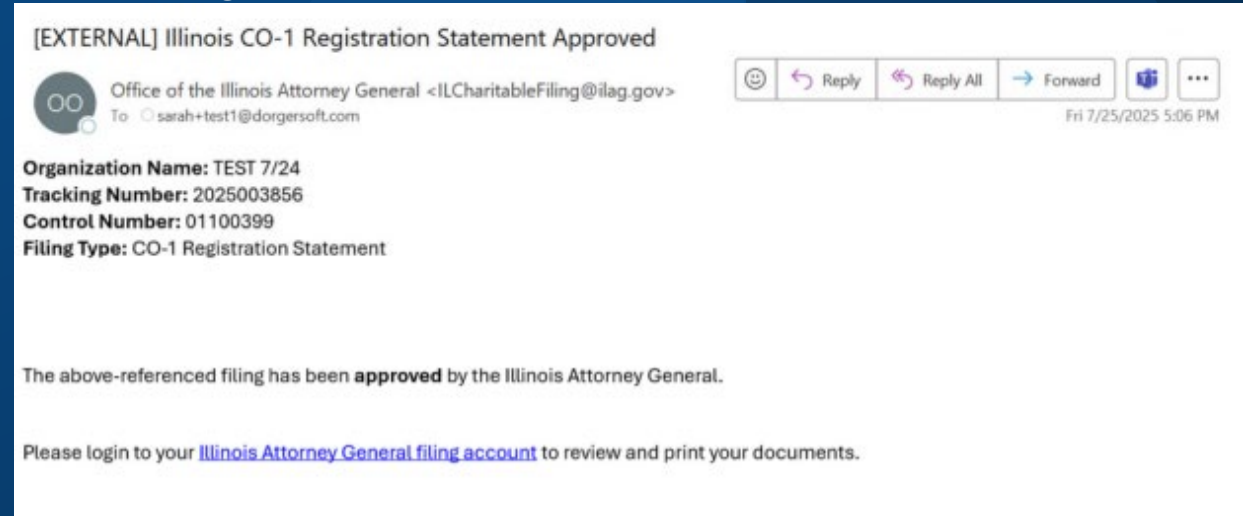

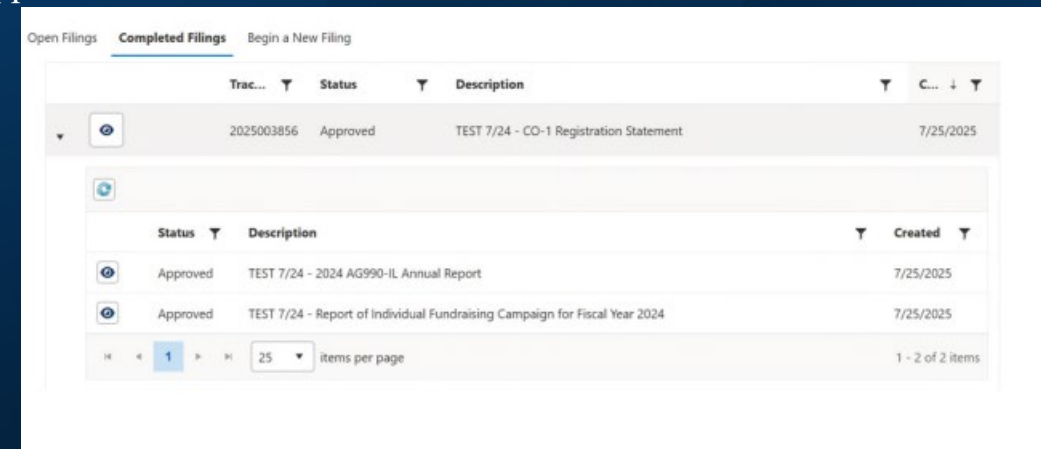

Charitable giving addresses many needs. Nonprofit organizations harness their mission-driven energy and donations to respond and react to numerous and sometimes dire circumstances.

- Protects the giving community from potential fraud and defends the public trust
- Upholds legal safeguards in place to ensure that charitable causes meet their financial responsibilities
- Registers organizations that receive donations
- Provides information on charitable organizations' resources and responsibilities.

Because Illinoisans rely heavily on the services provided by charities, Attorney General Kwame Raoul encourages consumers to practice wise charitable giving.

All charitable organizations that solicit donations or hold charitable assets in Illinois are required to register with Attorney General Kwame Raoul's Office.

Members of the public can check the online Charitable database to search if a charity or private foundation is registered and compliant with reporting requirements.

The database provides financial information such as assets, income and annual financial reports. Do your research, give to organizations that you are confident in and don't hesitate to say No Thanks if a solicitation does not feel right.
