The Illinois Attorney General's Office is pleased to offer the **Adult/Adolescent Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Didactic Training** to improve the response to sexual assault patients. This training includes a combination of pre-coursework and live training held in Kankakee.

This training is for registered nurses, advanced practice providers and physicians who will be providing medical forensic services to sexual assault patients in the Emergency Department. Applicants must complete the application below and return along with a current resume. All participants are required to have an established mentor (AA SAFE, SANE-A, or AA SANE practicing in Illinois) who has received specialized training in the care of sexual assault patients. Applicants who do not currently work in a direct patient care capacity in an Emergency Department must identify a plan as to how they will complete the clinical training requirements and practice as a SANE or SAFE.

The Office of the Illinois Attorney General reserves the right to select participants for the training based upon specific selection criteria. To maximize the number of agencies and geographical areas represented at the training, the Attorney General's Office may limit the number of attendees from an agency or geographical area.
